MINDFUL SUMMIT 2025

A one-day symposium on the Science and Clinical Practice in Mental Health

by the

American Mission Hospital, Bahrain

The upcoming symposium promises to be an enlightening event focused on the intricate connections between genetics, neuromodulation, and mental health.

Untreated mental illness in the GCC results in at least 37.5 million productive working days lost annually – equivalent to \$3.5 billion – states the recent PwC Middle East report 2022 and argues on 'Why GCC Governments should invest more in Mental Health'. Approximately 15% of the GCC's population is suffering from mental health illness in any given year, according to the same report.

This one-day symposium investigates and discusses the mental health situations affecting individuals and organizational work forces.

The program features a series of thought-provoking presentations, starting with **Dr. Huda Mossa Omran** from the Arabian Gulf University, who will explore *Genetics and Mental Health: Unlocking the Connection* shedding light on how genetic factors influence mental health conditions.

Following this, **Dr. Frans Cronje**, an Aviation and Aerospace Medicine Specialist, will discuss *Neuromodulation in Mental Health Optimization*, highlighting innovative therapeutic techniques.

Deligates will have a chance to network during lunch on the 5th floor south before diving into an insightful session led by **Dr. Charlotte Kamel** on *A Comprehensive Review of Suicide*, where she will present an in-depth analysis of suicide trends and prevention strategies.

Dr. John Stapert, a renowned clinical psychologist from Phoenix, Arizona, USA will make a presentation focusing on *Mental Health and the Female Reproductive System*, examining how biological and hormonal changes can inform mental health treatment decisions.

This symposium seeks to foster dialogue among mental health professionals, encourage collaborative learning, and address pivotal issues within the field, making it a valuable opportunity for all participants.

A key attraction of the day will be the release of the *Mental Health Capsule* by **Dr. Feba Paul** which will be a handy guide to people, with the hospital clinical psychologist's take on well-being.



Dr. Charlotte Awad Kamel
Consultant Psychiatrist

I began my training in 1980 at University Hospitals of Liverpool and Guys & St Thomas' in London, earning a diploma in psychiatry in 1982, membership in the Royal College of Psychiatrists in 1984, and fellowship in 1996. I also received a Diploma in Health Care Management from the Royal College of Surgeons in Ireland in 2000.

In 1989, I moved to Bahrain as a Consultant Psychiatrist with the Ministry of Health, where I helped develop mental health services based on the British system. From 1990 to 2008, I worked at the Arabian Gulf University and since 2009 have been an Associate Professor and Head of the Department of Psychiatry at the Royal College of Surgeons in Ireland – Medical University of Bahrain.

I coordinated the Diploma in Psychological Medicine program from 1994 to 2000, training primary care doctors in Bahrain to improve early psychiatric detection. I also chaired several psychiatry conferences in Bahrain, in collaboration with the Royal College of Psychiatrists, the World Psychiatric Association, and the Arabian Gulf Psychiatric Association.

Dr. Huda Mossa Omran, a Molecular Genetics Specialist in Bahrain, specializes in genetic counseling, chromosomal disorders, and reproductive genetics. She holds an MB ChB from the University of Basra and a PhD in Molecular Medicine from Arabian Gulf University.

A published researcher, she focuses on reproductive and longevity genetics. She has held leadership roles at Arabian Gulf University and Pulse Health Training Center and is currently at Al Aljenan Medical Center. She is also a member of the Genetic Society of America and the Global Andrology Forum.

Dr. John Charles Stapert is a Clinical Psychologist with 30 years of practice in Phoenix, Arizona.

He holds a B.A. from Hope College and an M.Div. from Fuller Theological Seminary, along with an M.A. and Ph.D. from the University of Illinois.

His career spans academia, church administration, and journalism, earning him the William B. Lippard Award in 2016. An influential figure in Arizona's psychology community, he has held leadership roles in the Arizona Psychological Association, receiving its Distinguished Mentor Award and the Aaron and Mathilda Canter Award.

In 2015, he was appointed to the Board of Directors of American Mission Hospital in Bahrain and will become Board Member Emeritus in 2025.

Dr. Cronje is a pioneer of modern hyperbaric oxygen therapy in Southern Africa, dedicated to its advancement since 1994. He founded the first clinical hyperbaric facilities in both the South African Military and private sectors and developed the region's first multidisciplinary training program in Hyperbaric Medicine. As Founder and Past President of Divers Alert Network Southern Africa, he has championed diver safety. He has held key roles at Stellenbosch University, the International Congress of Hyperbaric Medicine, SAUHMA, and WHASA, shaping research, training, and clinical practice in the field.

Dr. Vivek Mathew is a psychiatrist with over thirteen years of clinical experience dealing with adult, adolescent, and child mental health issues.




